## WINSTON

### VITICULTURAL NOTES

The fruit for this wine was grown in the Granite Belt Region, located on the Great Dividing Range 200km South West of Brisbane and 95km inland. James Halliday says that the key to the Granite Belt Region lies in its high altitude (between 600 and 1000m above sea level).

This high elevation means that the region is considered a cool climate region not only by Queensland standards, but also by worldwide viticultural standards. The altitude combined with the free draining Granite soils makes the region ideally suited to growing grapes.

### TASTING NOTES

Winston is fresh and lively with a wide range of flavours on his palate. He will take you on a wild ride but beware, he's pretty upfront about it.

### COLOUR

Pale straw

### NOSE

Capsicum, citrus and grassy herbaceous aromas

### PALATE

Citrus and passion fruit with tropical fruit undertones and firm acidity
